

Four Week Mini-Course at the SEE Science Center

Creative Computing Challenge:

Design and Build Mobile Apps using MIT App Inventor!

Saturdays March 24 - April 14th 10:00 am - 12:00 pm

In this program, students will learn the basics of MIT App Inventor and how to design and their very own app that can be used on a tablet or mobile android device. This is an introductory program for students who have little or no coding experience. Both computer based and program design elements are introduced.

Prerequisites: Students must be comfortable navigating on a computer, finding, downloading, saving, and uploading files and have access to a gmail account to share files.

This program is being offered as part of the STEM Docent program of the UNH Cooperative Extension and will be conducted by a trained STEM Docent. The goal of STEM Docent program is to offer hands-on learning opportunities for youth to strengthen STEM foundations in order to meet the expected workforce needs in the state.

**The cost is \$90 per student (\$80 for SEE members)
For Students in grades 7 to 12 who meet the prerequisites.
The course is limited to 10 participants.**
